

During my time in the police I undertook many training courses and gained a strong skill set in the area of child protection. As stated previously I have trained many police how to identify indicators of abuse. Such training is not only for police. It has actually been used by industries such as airlines for many years due to issues with international human trafficking.

If elected to the board I would be willing to consult with SwimmingSA about how strengthen its policies, procedures and training due to the high risk nature of our sport.

Further to this, I am a pilot and I own my own aircraft. I would be willing to travel to remote areas of the state with the assistance of Swimming SA to support country clubs if the need was identified.
