


Event Briefing 2024 Christmas Cracker (21 – 23 December)

Welcome to the 2024 Christmas Cracker! Please review this event information to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience.

SAALC refurbishment - changes to warm up & cool down

Some areas of the SA Aquatic and Leisure Centre are currently undergoing refurbishment, affecting the water polo/dive pool and certain change facilities in the leisure area. During this time, competing athletes only will have access to warm-up and cool-down space in the 25m program pool within the leisure area. This space can be accessed via the main corridor on the ground floor and will require accreditation. Please note that this lane space will be available for all sessions except session two.



To facilitate this, additional venue staff will be on hand to assist athletes moving between the competition area and the leisure area. Competing athletes only will receive accreditation passes to access the 25m program pool and return to the competition area. Accreditations will be distributed to Team Managers during the first briefing on Saturday 21 December. Clubs are responsible for managing the distribution of passes throughout the event.

Warm up lanes will open 15 minutes before the start of racing and remain available until the end of each session (excluding session two). Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

- Session 2, 4 12:00pm

Ticketing & registrations

Spectators are required to pre-purchase tickets via Swim Central as there will be **no ticket sales** at the venue. Printed tickets are not necessary, your name will be checked upon entry. Coaches, officials, team managers and carers must register through Swim Central to gain access.

Please note: No registration, no ticket = no entry.
