

## 1. Event Operating Hours

## 2. Timelines

## 3. Food and Drink

The grandstand Kiosk will be available for food and beverages.

## 4. Competition Rules

Masters Swimming Australia Rules as at close of entries will apply.

## 5. Officiating

The official's room will be located in the Boardroom behind the AOE Room.

Officials Briefing is 30mins prior to the start of each session (8:30am each morning) in the Boardroom – please ensure you are on time for the briefing.

## 6. Warm Up

The competition pool is only available for warm up prior to the Meet between 7:45am – 8:45am.

Warm up or cool down for swimmers during the Meet is available in the 25m pool at the western end of the competition pool. Swimmers, please note the Water Polo and Diving pool is not in use for warm up or cool down.

## 7. Warm Up Procedures

During warm up or cool down please obey the yellow signage at the end of each lane.

Diving is not permitted at anytime during warm up or cool down unless in the designated lane in the competition pool.

## 8. Marshalling

**Swimmers - Please do not attend marshalling until your event is listed on the marshalling board which is on pool deck.**

Athletes are **NOT required** to surrender their accreditation pass at Marshalling when checking in but must have it with them to show the marshals.

## 9. Relays

Nominations for relay events are to be made at the swimming venue when called for.

Combined ages of relays are as per Masters Australia Rules:

72 – 119 years	120 – 159 years	160 – 199 years	200 – 239 years
240 – 279 years	280 – 319 years	320 – 359 years	360 – 399 years

Participating swimmers may only swim once in each relay event and must have entered at least one individual event.

Relay entry cards will be available from the swimming information table and must be completed indicating the four swimmers' names, ages, the age total and name of team.

Mixed relay teams are to consist of two male and two female swimmers.

Swimmers may leave their names at the information desk if they would like to swim in a team event and teams will be made up with hope of all swimmers being placed.

A Program for the team events will be placed on the wall by the Results area when completed prior to the swim.

## 10. Meet Programs and Results

Meet Programs will be available at the desk at Event Entry on the day of Meet.

Result will be placed on the wall in corridor downstairs along from the Marshalling Room.

Meet Mobile and Live Results will be in use for results.

## 11. Venue Parking & Traffic Management

The Aquatic and Leisure Centre will be extremely busy during the two days of this event. SwimmingSA recommends the use of public transport to access the venue. Parking is not available for group transport vehicles on site or Westfield Marion. Drop off zones are located on Morphett Road (near Accreditation Entry) and on Warracowie Way (near Marion Cultural Centre).

## 12. Emergency Procedures

In the event of an emergency at the SA Aquatic and Leisure please listen carefully to stadium announcements and follow the direction of venue staff.

Stage 1: Upon hearing the alert tones (Beep.. Beep.. Beep..)

- Be aware of an emergency

DO NOT EVACUATE ON THIS TONE

Stage 2: Upon hearing the alert tones (Whoop.. Whoop.. "Evacuate Now")

- Evacuate the venue immediately via the nearest safe exit
- DO NOT USE ANY LIFTS
- Proceed to your nearest external assembly area
- DO NOT RE ENTER THE BUILDING until authorised

The emergency assembly area is located at the northern side of Bunnings Warehouse (carpark) closest to the Centrelink/Medicare building.

## 14. Medal Presentation Protocols

Medals shall be awarded to the first three placegetters in each age group in each event, with gold for first place, silver for second and bronze for third. If equal placing occurs then medals shall be awarded to each equal placing, but the next following medal/s shall be omitted.

We hope to present medals during racing and during breaks in racing.

Separate medals will be awarded to Multi Class swimmers who were officially classified prior to Meet. They are ineligible for able body medals.

## 15. First Aid

Venue staff are trained in first responder care and will be providing general first aid coverage for all people attending the event.

## 16. Photography

Photography on pool deck is only allowed if has been pre-approved by the organisers.
