Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a registered member of ASCTA 2. Hold a minimum of Swimming Australia Development Coach Accreditation 3. Have athletes selected to the South Australian Team (<i>preferable but not essential</i>) 4. Hold a current DCSI Child-Related Employment Screening or DHS Child related Employment/Volunteer Screening. 5. Submitted an application form housed on Swimming SA web page by the closing date of 5pm 31st of May
Team Commitments	<p>All team coaches must agree to</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the SwimmingSA Code of Conduct & Policies 2. Comply with the Swimming Australia Member & Child Welfare Policies 3. Comply with Department for Education School Sport SA Policies and procedures 4. Be available for the duration of the teams competition and preparation including the team training day prior to the competition 5. Attend all official team activities and aid in the supervision/welfare of <u>both the School Sport SA 12 and under and 13-18 years teams</u> throughout the trip/meet.
Selection Requirements	<p>To be considered for selection a coach must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have athletes selected to the SA Team (where possible) 2. Be available for all team commitments 3. Have a proven track record of coaching large groups of swimmers
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>2 X positions are being selected for the roll of team coaches.</u> • <u>Please note that this years coaches will be responsible for coaching both the Senior (13-18 years) and the Junior Team (10-12 years).</u> • Volunteer coaches selected with 2019 Swimming team will receive an incidentals payment of \$30.00 per day while attending the competition from School Sport SA. • Coaches will also receive a full team uniform.
