

# POLICY

## Provision of Technical Officials to External Bodies

POLICY No: 5010

EFFECTIVE: 12 June 2007



The purpose of this document is to provide control the methods we use to provide our trained volunteers to other organisations.

---

### *THE POLICY*

---

External bodies requesting the provision of SwimmingSA Technical Officials to work at their meets shall be required to supply details of the organisational, management and procedural aspects of their meet in addition to any special swimming rules which are to be applied.

The General Manager will use this information to recommend whether to:-

- agree to the request, or
- direct the application for support to a Club, or
- reject the request.

The Technical Committee may be consulted where concerns exist with respect to any aspect of the rules or procedures to be employed.

As a matter of general policy, SwimmingSA should where possible:-

- not provide Timekeepers to any external organisation unless the Board determines special circumstances exist which justify the provision of Timekeepers
- provide a Referee and a Starter for meets conducted by the Armed Services, Police, Fire Brigade and Masters Swimming Australia.
- generally provide up to 2 Referees, 1 Starter, 2 Judges of Stroke and 1 Chief Timekeeper to assist other external organisations conduct swim meets.
- for school based meets, provide an additional 2 Timekeepers' Stewards and 1 Announcer whenever possible.
