The purpose of this document is to provide information on the Fee's Charged at SwimmingSA:

## THE POLICY

SwimmingSA Charges fee's for many of the services we provide our members to (a) pay for current expenses, (b) provide services to members and (c) ensure the sport remains sustainable into the future.

Card Payment Fees are charged on all transactions processed through Clublane or Mylane.

For Membership Renewals: There are two fee's charged for a membership renewal.

• Merchant Fee: 1.5% of total invoice

• System Maintenance Fee: 2.5% of total invoice

For Event Entries: There is one fee charged for each event entry

Merchant Fee: 1.5% of total invoice

Any fee charged on a payment through Clublane or Mylane is reflected at the bottom of your invoice. All your recent invoices are available under your Clublane or Mylane profile (see invoice tab).

Recently, the Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) released regulatory changes associated with card payment fees. In line with the RBA's requirements, we will be reviewing the percentage charged on card payment fees for transactions. Any required changes will take effect for transactions made on and after 1 September 2017 in line with the RBA's Implementation plan.
