



## SwimmingSA/ASCTA-SA Coach Scholarship Application

SwimmingSA and ASCTA-SA are pleased to announce that they are creating a new scholarship opportunity for up to 6 South Australian Coaches to participate in a 12 month Gold Class Swimming Online Swim Coach Advantage Program.

A maximum six scholarships will be awarded in total with 4 scholarships being reserved for regional based coaches and 2 being reserved for metropolitan based coaches.

To be eligible for a scholarship you must meet <u>ALL</u> of the following requirements:

- Be a current ASCTA registered member for the 2018-2019 season
- Have held a coaching qualification for a minimum of 2 years (Comp strokes included)
- Have access to appropriate computer and internet services in your home/work environment
- Provide a letter from your Swimming Club that states the following:
  - o The Swimming Club/programs support of your application
  - o Confirmation that you are actively coaching a minimum of 6 hours per week
  - o Confirmation that the Swimming Club is willing to contribute \$91 to the program.

Scholarships selection will be based on their submission in relation to:

- Goals for your Coaching Career
- What you hope to achieve from participating in the Gold Class Coaching Program
- The hardships you face in relation to accessing traditional Coach Development opportunities
- How your Club will benefit from the scholarship and achieve better outcomes

## What will you get:

- Access to a 12 month membership of the Gold Class Swimming Coach Advantage Program.
- Participation in 2 X Group Mentoring Sessions with an ASCTA-SA Coach Representative
- Invitation to a minimum of 1 Gold Class Swimming Stroke Session led by Leigh Nugent

Total value of the Gold Class Swimming Online Swim Coach Advantage Program is approx. \$436.00

- Hold a current Coaching qualification for a minimum of 2 years
- Show evidence of regular minimum weekly coaching hours of 6 hours
- Be affiliated or officially recognised as a coach of a South Australian Swimming Club
- Have access and knowledge to appropriate computing and internet facilities

- The Swimming Club/Programs support of your application
- Confirmation that you are actively coaching a minimum of 6 hours per week
- Confirmation that he swimming club is will contribute \$91 to the program
