

NATIONAL INTEGRITY FRAMEWORK

Our policies have recently changed with the introduction of the National Integrity Framework. We will be working together over the next few months to upskill our community members in this space.

SA legislation requires organisations who provide services for children to ensure a child safe environment by:

- Create & maintain an environment that is both child safe and child friendly.
- Meet the legal requirements of the Children & Young People (Safety) Act 2017 and the Child Safety (Prohibited Persons) Act 2016.
- Lodge a child safe environments compliance statement with the Department of Human Services.

Please note SwimmingSA has lodged updated Child Safe Environment Compliance Statement on behalf of each club and association.

As part of affiliation for the 2023-24 season Clubs will need to ensure a minimum of two committee members have undertaken the National Integrity Framework training course.

The training will provide sporting administrators with background on why the NIF has been implemented including an overview of each policy. The National Integrity Framework is a suite of policies that sets out unacceptable behaviours in sport and how Complaints are managed under the Framework.
