

GO002 – Conditions Of Entry

INTRODUCTION

The Conditions of Entry Policy clearly defines management's responsibilities in the system for the design, development, authorisation, distribution, review and control of the facilities Policies, Quality Manuals and Procedures.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

For the safety and comfort of all users of this Aquatic & Recreation Centre please observe the prohibition and general warning symbols.

- This is a non-smoking venue
- Please observe pool rules at all times
- Please shower before entering the water
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry
- Any persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the centre
- Members and guests are required to follow staff directions at all times, failure to do so may result in eviction from the Centre
- Anyone attempting to gain entry without paying or without authorisation will be prosecuted
- Glass bottles, other articles containing glass and sharp objects are not to be carried or used within the slide, or the aquatic areas
- Abusive, disruptive or offensive behaviour and language are not permitted
- children under 5 must have a responsible adult in the water and within arm's reach at all times
- Children under 10 must be accompanied in the Centre and actively supervised by a responsible person over 16 years of age
- The Centre caters for all food and beverage requirements. Commercial fast foods are not permitted
- No pets or animals permitted in the Centre, with the exception of Guide Dogs
- Management welcomes the capturing of your magic moments on camera and video cameras however the privacy of others must be respected. The use of camera and video cameras at this venue is conditional upon the following
 - You must have all relevant individuals consent to take and use images
 - It is illegal to broadcast or publish images without consent
 - Under no circumstances are cameras, video cameras and mobile phones to be used in the change rooms

- Any cooking device or associated flammable materials
- Helium balloons

Other

- No pets or animals permitted in the Centre, with the exception of Guide Dogs (as per conditions of entry)
- Any other item that in the opinion of management could cause harm or public nuisance.
