

Inspector of Turns - Finish End

STROKE	START	AFTER START	DURING RACE	FINISH OF RACE
FREESTYLE BACKSTROKE - NO LEDGE	Stay sitting	Stand next to block when swimmer reaches the 15m mark on the return length (or 1 st length if 50m long course)	Remain standing next to the block to observe the turns and remain standing until the end of the race	Standing next to the block, observe the finish, press SAT button or stopwatch if present, then sit down
BACKSTROKE - LEDGE	1 st Whistle - stand at the side of the block (on boom if present) 2 nd whistle - check swimmers toes/part of foot are in contact with the wall Take a slight step back when happy	Remove ledge, stay at the side of the block to observe turns or finishes	"	"
BUTTERFLY BREASTSTROKE IM	1 st Whistle - stand at the back and to one side of the block (not on the boom) After start signal is given step immediately onto the boom or next to the block at the side of the pool to observe the stroke	Remain standing next to the block to observe turns	"	"
RELAYS	See freestyle, backstroke with or without ledges	As above plus observe relay change overs	"	"

For 50m LC starts, please observe the same starts, but sit after the last swimmer passes the 15m mark

FREESTYLE BACKSTROKE - NO LEDGE	Stay sitting	Stand next to block when swimmer reaches the 15m mark on the return length (or 1 st length if 50m long course)	Remain standing next to the block to observe the turns and remain standing until the end of the race	Standing next to the block, observe the finish, press SAT button or stopwatch if present, then sit down
BACKSTROKE - LEDGE	1 st Whistle - stand at the side of the block (on boom if present) 2 nd whistle - check swimmers toes/part of foot are in contact with the wall Take a slight step back when happy	Remove ledge, stay at the side of the block to observe turns or finishes	"	"
BUTTERFLY BREASTSTROKE IM	1 st Whistle - stand at the back and to one side of the block (not on the boom) After start signal is given step immediately onto the boom or next to the block at the side of the pool to observe the stroke	Remain standing next to the block to observe turns	"	"
RELAYS	See freestyle, backstroke with or without ledges	As above plus observe relay change overs	"	"

For 50m LC starts, please observe the same starts, but sit after the last swimmer passes the 15m mark
