

Coaches: coach's or teacher's ASCTA Recognition to be captured against their participant profile and display this recognition in their virtual membership card.

Updating the colour of virtual membership cards for coaches with Premiums ASCTA memberships. The colour of the card reflects their ASCTA Recognition level (Platinum, Gold, Silver, Bronze)



Event/Meet Update: Ensure an event does not exceed its session duration, maximum number of nominations per participant while still filling all lanes in each race, so that events run according to the planned schedule.

Allow the event manager to set entry limits for participants by session or by meet, so that it aligns with the respective settings in Meet Manager.

This will be of increasing importance with potential COVID-19 restrictions.

Event Page Filters: allowing events to be searched by type (All, Swim Meet, Social) and date categories (All, Historic, Upcoming).

Entity affiliation: has been released in Swim Central but SSA will notify clubs when full functionality is introduced for affiliations between entities.

"Affiliation Required" message on the club's Entity home page, so that clubs are prompted to purchase an affiliation, if one has not already been purchased.

Entity Account Contact: details updated or changed in Swim Central will be automatically updated in Stripe, whereby Stripe

- o verify the correct ID documentation is associated to the entity
- o ensure personal documents from former entity contacts are no longer used
- o ensure old contact documents are destroyed in accordance with privacy principles and data security.

CSV Report: generated in Swim Central for tickets purchased now includes all the information a meet administrator needs.

Bug fix: participants are now only able to purchase products within their publication dates. Whereas previously they could purchase a product after its expiration or availability date.
